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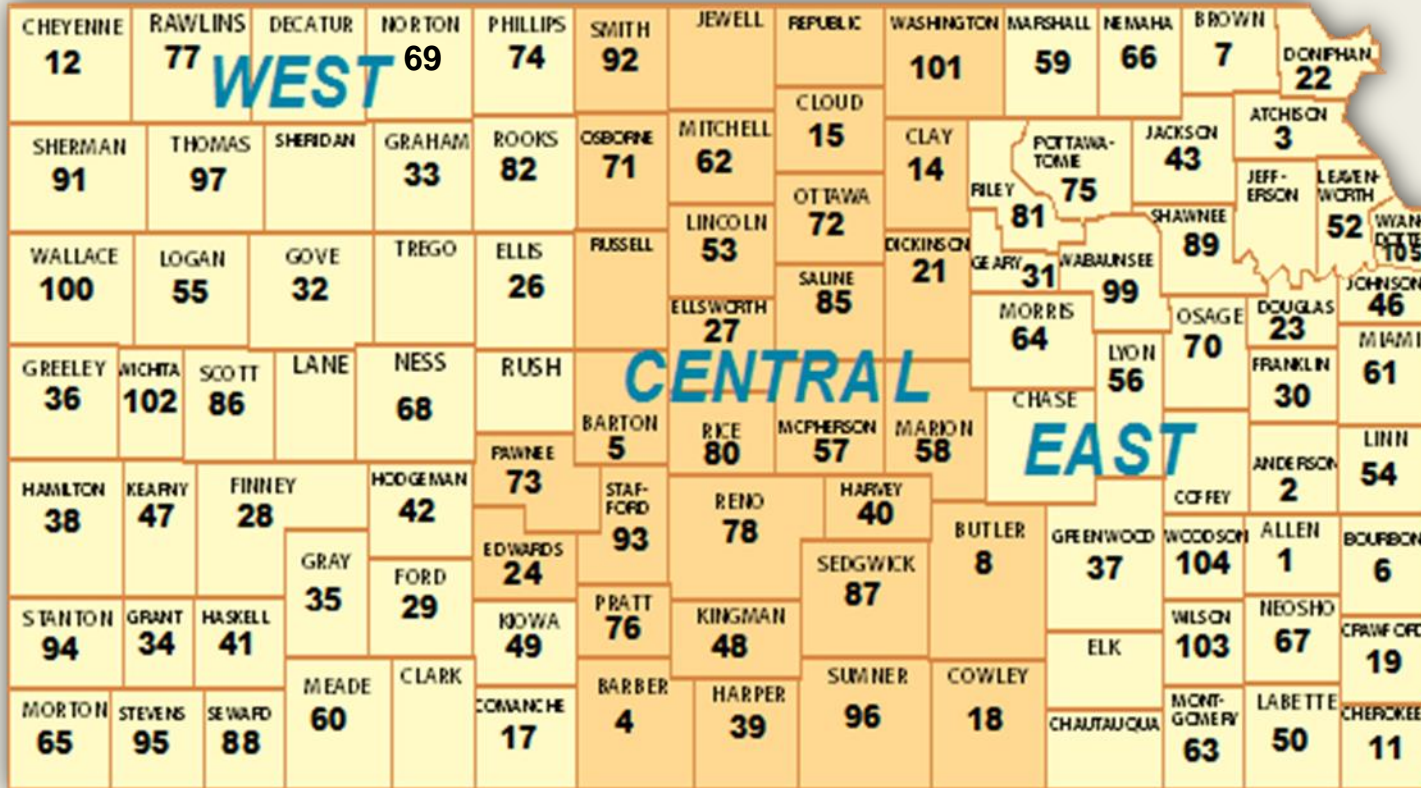

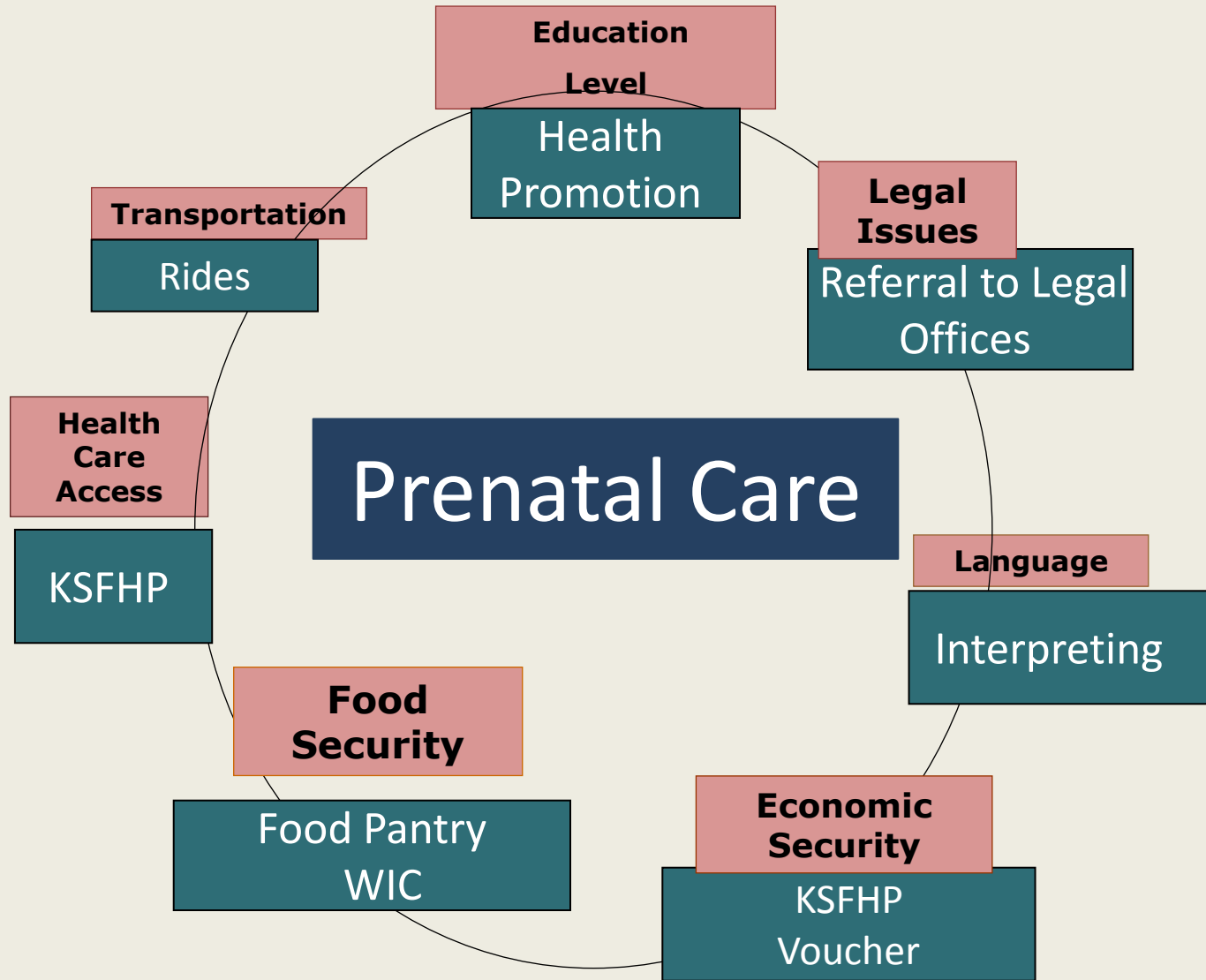


Identification of Barriers

2014 Health Status Survey & Annual Focus Groups:

- High Cost (includes no insurance)
- Language translation and interpretation
- Literacy levels
- Transportation and isolation
- Lack of history of preventive services
- Mobility of clients and distance to clinic
- Difficulty leaving work to get services
- Clinic not open when available for appointment

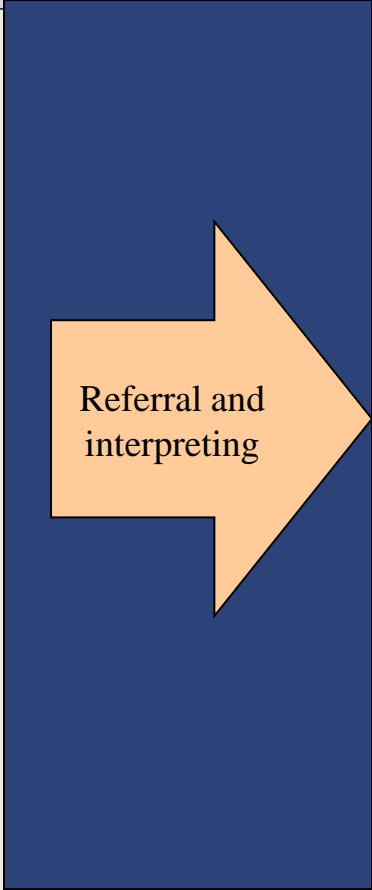

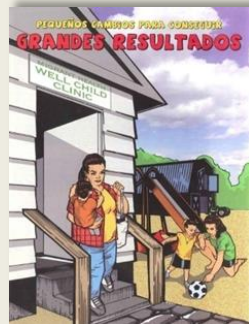
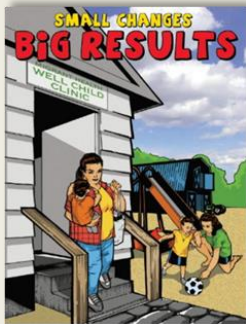
