Midwest Farmworker Stream Forum

The National Center for Farmworker Health has scholarship funds that have been made available through the Migrant Health Branch, Bureau of Primary Health Care to support attendance to this year's Midwest Farmworker Stream Forum. The Forum focuses on issues regarding the health of migrant and seasonal farmworkers. Although all applicants whose professions are related to migrant health qualify, priority will be given to those who provide service to farmworkers from the Midwestern states.

FUNDING SUPPORT: Up to \$500 per person. Funds are to be used for conference registration and /or travel expenses. A maximum of three (3) scholarships totaling \$1,500 may be awarded per agency or organization, funds must be used to support 3 or more people. Funds are awarded on a reimbursement basis following the conference once attendance has been verified.

LOGISTICS: The scholarship recipient will be responsible to register for the conference and make their own travel and hotel arrangements. Conference registration fees include: conference bag and program, all educational sessions, handout materials, continuing education credit application fees, continental breakfasts, breaks, dessert function, and evening receptions.

NOTIFICATION: Award notices to all applicants will be mailed by September 19, 2003.

SUBMISSIONS: Travel Scholarships are awarded to participants by professions and are selected through a committee process.
