After vaccination, some children may experience mild side effects for a few days.

These may include:

- Fatique
- Headache
- Fever
- Muscle aches
- Pain at the site of injection
- Chills
- Nausea

Side effects after vaccination are normal and show that the body is building protection against the virus! Call your child's health care provider if you have any concerns about your child's symptoms.

Vaccinating children will help reduce their risk of getting very sick from COVID-19 while they play, go to school, and visit family.



Keep wearing masks and staying six feet apart from others even if you're vaccinated.
