

Should I Be Tested?

If you feel sick and think you have symptoms of COVID-19, call your doctor or health provider. They can help you decide if you should be tested. COVID-19 testing is **FREE** under the Families First Coronavirus Response Act. Even if you do not have health insurance, testing for COVID-19 is **FREE**.

What To Do After You Are Tested



If you test **positive** for COVID-19, call your healthcare provider immediately.



If you test **negative** for COVID-19, it could mean a few different things:

- You were not infected at the time of testing; or
- You were at an early stage of the virus and the test did not detect it yet; or
- You already had the virus and recovered.

No matter what your test results are, it is important to protect yourself and others. Wear a mask, social distance, and wash your hands.
