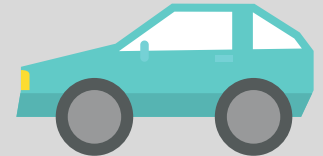

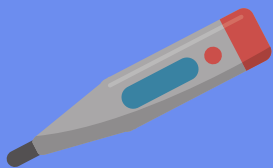
29% of Migrant Health Center visits, on average, were being conducted virtually
