

# MIGRANT HEALTH CENTERS & COVID-19

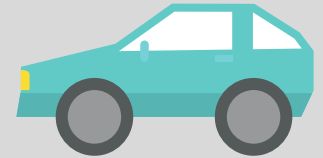

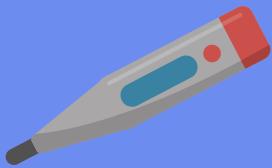
25% of Migrant Health Center visits, on average, were being conducted virtually

Of Migrant Health Centers reported having capacity to test for COVID-19



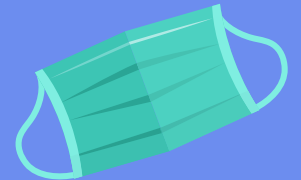
83% of Migrant Health Centers were offering drive-up COVID-19 testing
