THE COVID-19 VACCINE

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I GET IT?

EVERYONE HAS THE RIGHT TO GET VACCINATED!



AFTER GETTING THE VACCINE:

- It's possible that you'll feel fine, or that you have pain in your arm, headache, fever, chills, nausea, muscle pain, or tiredness for 1-3 days
- If you are going to move for work in the next few weeks, ask the clinic to write down the brand name of the vaccine



Step 2

IF YOU GET A VACCINE THAT REQUIRES TWO DOSES:

- You'll need to get the second dose 3-4 weeks after the first one
- You should receive both doses to avoid getting sick with COVID-19





AFTER GETTING ALL THE DOSES NEEDED:

- You should keep using a mask, washing your hands, and keeping 6 feet or 2 meters apart after getting vaccinated
- If you have more questions about the vaccine, ask your health care provider.



Until most people have been vaccinated against COVID-19, we still need to: use a mask, keep a distance of 6 feet or 2 meters, and wash our hands often.
