

THE COVID-19 VACCINE

THE DAY OF YOUR VACCINE APPOINTMENT

Everyone has the right to get vaccinated!

Step

1

- Arrive at least 15 minutes early to your appointment. Remember to wear a mask.
- Call to change your appointment if you are sick or have fever.
- If you're allergic to other vaccines, talk to a doctor before getting a COVID-19 vaccine.



Step

2

You'll get the injection in your arm.



Step

3

Stay for 10-15 minutes after you get the shot so that health care providers can make sure you're not allergic to the vaccine. Most people are not allergic to the vaccine, but they do this to be safe.



Step

4

Ask the staff if you need to schedule an appointment for the second dose (if it's needed) or if you should call later.

- Get the booster shots when you become eligible to lower your risk of getting very ill due to COVID-19.
- Wear a mask if you have had contact with anyone infected with COVID-19 or if there is a high risk of COVID-19 spread in your community.
- Get tested for COVID-19 if you feel any symptoms (cough, fever, etc.).
