This affirmation is made in support of the **AgWorkerAccess 2020 Campaign** and a nationwide effort to increase accessibility for this vulnerable population. In order to support the Campaign we commit to: (*Choose from among the following suggested activities*)

- Conduct an internal assessment of our current population service delivery rate in comparison to potential Ag Worker Patient Users for Medical, Dental and Behavioral Health services.
- Internally assess challenges and barriers which need to be addressed and the strengths with which we can improve access.
- Create a strategic or tactical plan to address challenges and strengthen response to needs (break it down by site and by week).
- Set Ag Worker Patient and Encounter Goals on a site-by-site basis, monitor and report back to the Board of Directors on a monthly basis.
- Forge collaborative relationships with local community organizations in order to support mutual service goals.
- Create visible points of reference to remind staff and patients of the importance our commitment to supporting access to quality care for medical, dental and behavioral health services for this population. - Make every effort to develop and recruit champions for Ag Worker Health at the staff, board and community levels, and to represent the needs of the population at the highest possible spheres of influence (local, regional and national).
- Develop and adopt a corporate response to offset negative community publicity so that health center champions are equipped to stand up to popular misconceptions about the populations we serve.
