WHEN CAN I GET IT?

EVERYONE HAS THE RIGHT TO GET VACCINATED!

THE COVID-19 VACCINE IS BEING GIVEN IN GROUPS:

Each state has their own plan, some agricultural workers may get vaccinated later in some states and earlier in others.

Everyone living or working in the United States has the right to get vaccinated, no matter what their immigration status is.

HOW CAN I KNOW WHEN IT'S MY TURN?

- Listen to your local radio station
- Watch the local news
- Call your Health Center, hospital, consulate office, or health care provider
- Ask your employer

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO TO GET THE VACCINE?

It's possible that you'll need to register online or call a number to get an appointment. It's different depending on where you live.

YOU CAN RECEIVE THE VACCINE:

- In a big building, like an auditorium or gymnasium
- In a local Health Center, clinic, or pharmacy
- In a hospital
- At work
- During a community event



Until most people have been vaccinated against COVID-19, we still need to: use a mask, keep a distance of 6 feet or 2 meters, and wash our hands often.
