Uses bulleted lists.		
 Illustrations are simple and serve to amplify the text. Large font (min. 12 point) with serifs is used. Photos are used to demonstrate "how-to" steps. Limited use of symbols. 		
No more than two or three font styles on a page		
Use of uppercase and lowercase text		
Avoidance of italics, stylish fonts, and reverse print		
Cultural and Linguistic Appropriateness		
Content is gender, age, and culturally appropriate of the target audience.		
The material acknowledges and incorporates cultural health knowledge and normal cultural practices.		
Text is vivid and interesting.		
Tone is friendly and not patronizing.		
 Is available in major indigenous languages? (Mixtec, Triqui, Mam, Ki'che, Maya) 		
 Content uses harm-reduction practices if best practices are not realistic in typical living/working conditions for farmworkers. 		
 Images show racially and age-diverse persons. 		



 Information has been tested with farmworkers or immigrant Latinos in other low-wage occupations.
