After vaccination, some children may experience mild side effects for a few days.

These may include:

- Fever
- Headache
- Chills
- Muscle aches
- Pain & swelling at the site of injection
- Swollen glands (most common under the armpit)
- Tiredness or sleepiness

- Side effects after vaccination are normal and show that the body is building protection against the virus!
- Call your child's health care provider if you have any concerns about your child's symptoms.

Vaccinating children will help them go to school, play, and visit family members and reduce their risk of getting very sick if they get COVID-19.



*Wear a mask when necessary in your community or if you have had close contact with someone infected with COVID-19.
