

National Center for Farmworker Health H5N1 Bird Flu Resources

NCFH has several resources that can help farmworker-serving organizations, health departments, and others plan their outreach to animal production workers, implement safe outreach practices, and share timely information about influenza vaccines and H5N1 bird flu prevention with animal production workers.

Animal Production Worker Data

<u>NCFH Farm labor Dashboard</u> shows concentrations of farmworkers (including both crop and livestock workers) by county and state across the United States, as well as information about seasonal labor fluctuations, locations of farmworkerserving organizations, and possible locations of farmworkers.

<u>Dairy Worker Estimates and Farms</u> map shows county-level estimates of dairy workers across the United States. Please note these estimates are a rough guideline and have not yet been validated.

<u>Farmworker COVID-19 Community Assessments</u> provide county-level reports for 16 different agricultural communities in the U.S., with almost 5,000 farmworker participants. Each report provides data about farmworker demographics, health care access, vaccine uptake, and communication preferences.
