Call for Health

Call for Health can help you with:

- Healthcare services to see a doctor or continue ongoing treatment.
- Legal aid, food, and transportation for medical appointments or COVID-19 tests and vaccines.
- Limited financial assistance for medical services and treatment.
- Interpretation in English and Spanish.

For emergencies in the US, dial 911 from any phone.

Anyone can call 911 to get help. Be ready with:

- Your Name
- Your Address (location of emergency)
- Describe the type of emergency - give important details
- If you don't speak English, you have the right to ask for an interpreter. Interpretation is not always available.

To ask for an interpreter:

English: "I need a Spanish interpreter please"

Spanish: Necesito un interprete en espanol, por favor



Sometimes healthcare in the U.S. costs money but we can help you find financial support.

**Do not worry about cost during an emergency,
your health is most important.**

Dial 911 from any phone for a	Who is usually financially responsible
A serious, urgent work injury	Workers' compensation insurance
Severe illness symptoms or life-threatening situation	If the illness or injury is not work-related, then the worker may have to pay the medical bills. Call for Health can help you find financial assistance programs that will cover hospital charges.
Serious COVID-19 symptoms such as trouble breathing	COVID-19 treatment is free if you do not have health insurance
Other emergencies like fire or flood	In the U.S., you do not have to pay for firefighters, police officers, or other public safety emergency responders.
